- Labels
- Single text
- Text
- UserPicker
- DatePicker
- DateTimePicker
- Single Select
- Select with multiple choices
- URL field

### 2. CRM custom field types

- Company/Companies
- Contact/Contacts
- Issue Picker
- Dictionary
- Product/Products
- Transactions
- Products&Services
